### We commit to:

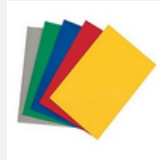
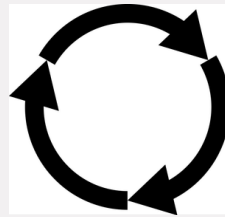
- **listening** to parents and the school and fostering **open and constructive communication**: WhatsApp groups to streamline communication.
